The 2nd S.S.No.3 became due 6,32 and no part of the survey has been held. The vessel has been laid up at Rotterdam since April 1931, and the usual undertaking has been furnished.

The vessel was last seen in dry dock in March 1930 when the Rotterdam Surveyors reported the bottom and rudder in good condition.

A letter has now been received from the Rotterdam Surveyors stating that the vessel has been sold to Italian Owners, subject to a certificate being granted to enable the vessel to proceed to an Italian port with a non-perishable cargo in order to be broken up.

It is submitted the Surveyors be informed that provided a general examination be held in accordance with Circular No.1605, a certificate could be issued to enable the vessel to proceed to an Italian port with a non-perishable cargo to be broken up.
