In answer to your letter of the 13th ult., we have to forward for consideration amended plan in duplicate:-


No 359= SHOWING BUILDERS PROPOSAL FOR DRAINING THE C DECK IN WAY OF THE PLATE BULWARKS IN THE ABOVE VESSEL.

As requested, on this plan has been indicated by the Builders, the position and dimensions of the scuppers for draining C deck and the doors giving access from the alleyways to the accommodation in the deckhouses.

The gangway floors proposed to be fitted are also indicated: the Builders state that these will be fitted with hinged doors.

We think it well to draw attention again to the free translation of Builders' letter of 6/9/27, to this office forwarded with our letter of the 10th ult., to you with special reference to the desire of the Owners to reduce, as far as possible, the number of freeing ports in this vessel, whose intended draught was 23 feet 7 1/2 inches, is less than that corresponding to a complete superstructure vessel.


