Dear Sirs,

I am in receipt of your letter of the 3rd instant forwarding for approval a plan shewing the arrangement of freeing ports in the bulwarks on the Upper deck (C) of Messrs. Ansaldo's No.283 ("AUSONIA") and with regard thereto I have to state that in view of the fact that the draught is 4'-6" less than that of a complete superstructure vessel it will only be necessary to fit a limited number of freeing ports in the bulwarks on the upper (C) deck, and provided seven freeing ports 600 m/m by 400 m/m be fitted on each side of the ship in the positions indicated on the plan, which is returned herewith, the same will be approved.
