Dear Sirs,

M. I am in receipt of your letter of the 16th instant forwarding a plan, in duplicate, of freeing ports proposed for Messrs. Ansaldo's No. 283 ("AUSONIA"), and with regard thereto I have to state that it will be necessary for efficient drainage to be provided in way of the large deckhouse amidships.

I therefore return the plans herewith and shall be glad if you will arrange for the Builders to indicate thereon the position and dimensions of the scuppers for draining C. deck, together with the number and position of the doors giving access from the alleyways to the accommodation in the large deckhouse. At the same time you should state if the openings indicated in the bulwarks are to be arranged as open gangways, or if they are to be fitted with hinged doors.
