

FREE TRANSLATION OF LETTER RECEIVED FROM
MESSRS ANSALDO - GENOVA-SESTRI- 6th September 1927

With reference to our conversation with your Surveyors, we have put your requests regarding the dimensions, number and position of the doors at ship's sides for the outlet of water from the upper deck, before the Naval Architect of the Owners of the above vessel, and in agreement with them, we have compiled plan No A. 283/359 which we herewith enclose in triplicate, and on which we have marked these doors on ship's sides as desired by them.

For our part, however, we wish to point out to you the fact that the great extension of the superstructure on C. deck, limits considerably the quantity of water that can occasionally come on deck, and we have noticed that the "ESPERIA" which is a little smaller than the "AUSONIA" and has been in service more than 10 years, has a fewer number of doors for the outlet of water than those marked on our enclosed plan they are much less in size (600 x 300 m/m) and in all these years no inconvenience due to this fact, has been felt.

Trusting you will agree with the proposals made by the Owners and ourselves,
