cast steel deadlights and forged naval brass securing bolts
and hinge pins have been tested in accordance with Board of
Trade Circular N°1485, and particulars of the test are
appended hereto . -

The side scuttles - when finished - were found
to be sound and free from apparent defects, and in our opinion,
are suitable for their intended purposes . -
