Mr. Woods, Superintendent for the Nelson Line, has been communicated with, and he states that although it is not impossible that general cargo may be carried in the 'tween decks when chilled meat is hung below, yet it is very improbable, as in such a case it is doubtful whether the ship would be in a stable condition.

The Owners have proposed wood supports and runners under the second deck beams, with a view to carrying cargo in the 'tween decks in addition to chilled meat hanging from the beams, but they did not consider the question as to whether that 'tween deck cargo would be general cargo or frozen meat.
