Closing appliances as per Load Line Certificate checked and found in good order.

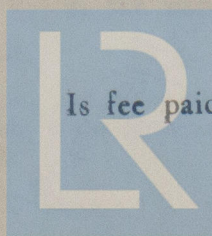
NOTE:- Copy of original freeboard report could not be obtained in the time available.
