F. I have to acquaint you the Convention freeboard certificate of the steamer "SAXICAVA" will expire on the 31st May next and as the Committee have agreed to the Special Survey No. 3 being carried out some time within the year of grace, viz. by the end of September, 1935, the Owners desire the validity of the freeboard certificate extended accordingly.

The Owners state that arrangements have been made to drydock the vessel at Singapore on or about the 20th proximo when the certificate can be extended and I shall therefore be glad if you will arrange to carry out a general examination at that time and endorse the certificate for extension until the 30th September, 1935.
