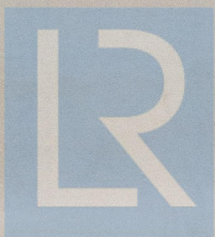


Show hereon line of Floors or Tank Top with position of any Brakes in same; also height of Peak Tank tops, &c., &c.
