With reference to the classification in this Society's Register Book of the steamer "MARYAD", which is reported to have been bombed and set on fire at Alicante on the 4th instant, I am directed to say that the Committee will be much obliged if you will kindly favour them with the latest information which you have received as to the extent of damage, etc., and if you will be so good as to say also what course it is intended to pursue as regards the repair of the vessel.

The question of making a record of the circumstances against the vessel's name in the Register Book will come under the Committee's notice on the 8th proximo, and it is the practice in cases where it is thought necessary to make such a notation, to expunge at the same time the vessel's class from the Register Book.

I shall therefore be glad if you will kindly apprise me for the Committee's information of your views on this point.
