SURVEY REPORT

Pursuant to the foregoing Order unto me/us directed, the Undersigned, did repair on board the S/S "MARYAD" and did then and there hold the required Survey. And we do accordingly declare and report as follows:

- That the above steamer has been apparently badly shaken midships in such a manner as to cause all wooden decks upper and lower bridge to be slightly sprung, but iron framing and combings apparently in good sound condition.

Repairs necessary all midship wooden deck to be caulked, also wooden deck in way of after winch bearings require caulking.

We estimate the cost of repairs to amount to about £.50 (fifty Pounds Sterling).

We, undersigned are perfectly satisfied that the S/S "MARYAD" is in a seaworthy condition and fit to carry cargo in bulk.
