^{but} This vessel has been under survey at Marseilles for re-classification. Owing to the War she was purchased by the French Government and classed with the B.V. only, so our interest in her has ceased.

I spoke to Mr. Sladden about it to-day and instead of giving her a "Now trading record", he has thought it best in all the circumstances to omit the record of "Damaged by aircraft 6,33" on the reprint of the R.B. Also put in the French Government as Owners on the reprint and anything else you pick up in the 1940 B.V. Register Book and/or supplements.

So will you kindly make a note of this for the 1940/41 Register Book.
