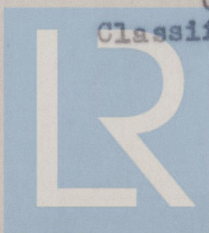
I have to inform you, however, that although this vessel was built before the Rule as regards Sulphur prints came into force, it is considered that any repairs now being effected should comply with the requirements of the present Rules, and unless the rivets in question are cut out and renewed by ones of material of proper quality, there will therefore be no alternative but to decline to proceed with the Reclassification Survey.
