The Board of Trade have ordered a Formal Investigation into the circumstances attending the loss of the above named vessel.

The hearing has not been definitely fixed but will in all probability commence in Sunderland in about a month's time.

I should be grateful if you would allow Mr. Watt to produce the Computations for Freeboard, Survey Reports and Load Line Certificate, as he has done in previous cases. In addition, the Court will wish to have the evidence of your Surveyors who dealt with the last two dry dock surveys, which I believe were carried out in December, ¹⁹³⁶~~1926~~, and April, 1937. Perhaps you would be good enough to give me the full names and addresses of these Surveyors.
