Nature of Survey


The Hull Surveyors report this vessel placed in dry dock, bottom cleaned and coated and on account of damage through heavy weather, 1 shellplate has been renewed, 10 shell plates repaired, about 1450 rivets renewed and 29 tank lugs repaired and minor repairs carried out.

It is submitted the vessel appears worthy to remain as classed with record of survey 12,33.
