Dear Sirs,

With Reference to the classification in the Society's Register Book of the steamer "BARON BAEYENS", I beg to acquaint you that the Second Special Survey No.3 became due in August 1932 but has not yet been completed, and the year of grace allowed for the survey has consequently expired.

The Committee have had the case before them today together with a letter from the Society's Surveyors at Antwerp enclosing one from you intimating that the vessel is to be laid up and that you do not intend to complete the Special Survey at present.

In all the circumstances I have to say that the Committee are agreeable to the vessel's class in the Register Book remaining undisturbed for the present whilst she is laid up, subject to the conditions set forth on the enclosed form of undertaking which I shall be glad if you will kindly sign and return to this Office.
