The 2nd S.S.No.3, due 6,31 has been partly held.

The class is subject to permanent repairs being carried out to the bulkhead between Nos. 3 & 4 main cargo tanks port side at the Owners' earliest convenience and to the deck plating in way of Nos. 4 & 5 cargo tanks, which is slightly buckled, being specially examined at the next dry docking.

The vessel has been laid up in the Tyne since October 1931 and the usual undertaking has been furnished.

On the 5th instant the Owners advised this Office that the vessel had been sold for breaking up purposes, and would be delivered to the purchasers, Messrs. South Stockton Shipbreaking Co.Ld., Stockton on Tees, in the River Tyne.

In reply to enquiry the Newcastle Surveyors state that they have been informed by the Owners' local representative that the vessel was to be towed to Stockton for breaking up and was expected to leave the Tyne on the 9th instant.

It is a matter for consideration whether the class should not now be dealt with.
