Nature of Survey \_\_\_\_\_

The class is subject to temporarily repaired deck plate on port side of bunker tween deck being dealt with at the Owners' convenience.

The Dublin Surveyor now reports the vessel examined afloat and on account of damage through ice, temporary repairs have been effected to shell plating etc.

The Surveyor recommends the vessel be placed in dry dock for examination and permanent repairs at the first convenient opportunity.

The bunker tween deck plate referred to above has not been dealt with.

It is submitted the vessel appears worthy to remain as classed without record of survey subject as recommended and as above.
