Dear Sirs,

H. I have to inform you that on the 18th ultimo the Society's Surveyors at Amsterdam stated that the steamers "RONDO" & "ROTTI" had been sold to Italian buyers for breaking up purposes, after being laid up for some time. Reports have now come to hand from the Amsterdam Surveyors from which it appears that satisfactory General Examinations of these ships have been carried out and that in the Surveyors' opinion the vessels are fit for the voyage to Italy. In the circumstances I shall be glad if you will be guided accordingly, and you will be good enough to advise me immediately the work of demolition is commenced.


