I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 21st instant respecting the steamers "RONDO" and "ROTTI", which vessels I note have been sold for breaking up in Italy, and that the new Owners desire to be furnished with an Interim Certificate for the voyage from your port.

The Committee have had the cases under consideration at their meeting today, and I am directed to inform you that, provided you satisfy yourselves that these vessels are in a fit condition to proceed on the contemplated voyage (paying particular regard to the steering gear and windlass) and that the boilers and machinery are submitted to a satisfactory examination and test under steam, the Committee will be agreeable to your issuing the necessary certificates.

Your reports on the cases are awaited.


