

S.S. "ROTTI"

This vessel was built in 1914-8. The S.S.No.3 was held in 7,26, and the 2nd S.S.No.1 in 1930. The boiler survey became due in April. 1932. No survey is due on the hull.

The vessel is laid up at Amsterdam, and a letter has been received from the Surveyors stating that the vessel has been sold for breaking up purposes, and that the new Owners desire a certificate for a voyage to Italy for this purpose. They state that in the meantime the boilers and machinery have been submitted for examination and will be tested under steam.

This vessel would appear to have been laid up since November 1930, but as no survey is due on the hull, there would appear to be no objection to her proceeding to Italy for breaking up, provided the Surveyors are satisfied that she is in fit condition to do so, particularly with regard to the steering gear and windlass.

The ship was last surveyed in dry dock in July 1930 when the 2nd S.S.No.1 was held.
