
S.S. "MILLPOOL".

We are in receipt of your communication of yesterday's date and in reply to your enquiry we would mention that the last news sent out by the "MILLPOOL" was apparently a wireless message at about 2 o'clock on the 3rd October, this message however was indecipherable. No news has been received of the vessel since the 3rd October and we fear that it must now be definitely assumed that the steamer foundered on the morning of the 3rd October at approximately latitude 53.30 north, longitude 37.10 west.

There is therefore no object in further delaying the withdrawal from your Register Book.
