We have now obtained a copy of the Findings and Annex in this matter and we enclose herewith two copies of it for your use.

We have already reported to you by our letter of yesterday the general nature of the Findings, and we think that the only further point to which we need draw attention is that mentioned in the first paragraph on page 17, where the suggestion is made as to the possible need for revision of the rules and procedure in respect of the periodical surveys of ships of the age of the "Millpool".

This point is one which will no doubt receive the careful attention of the Society; and although the Court appears to be of the opinion that there is possibly a lesson to be learned in this respect from the case of the "Millpool", we think it may certainly be said that the Inquiry has not resulted in any serious criticism of the Society, or of the surveyors in the conduct of their duties.
