As arranged with you on the telephone this afternoon we send you herewith a copy of the letter which on Counsel's advice we are addressing to the Board of Trade Solicitor in connection with this matter.

We also enclose a copy of the note, which we ourselves have prepared for Counsel's information, upon the history and constitution of the Society, the contents of which we trust will be found correct. Counsel thinks that it is quite possible that either the Solicitor General or alternatively Lord Merrivale may take the view that no statement as to the Society's constitution and origin should be made unless evidence of the facts is tendered, and that we should hold ourselves in readiness to tender^a/witness who can speak to these facts, as set out in the memorandum enclosed. We suggest that the most suitable witness for this purpose would be Sir Andrew Scott, if it were convenient for him to be available.
