With reference to your letter of the 14th instant regarding the survey for freeboard carried out in May 1932 by Mr. C. Stephenson, who at that time was a temporary Surveyor on the Society's Staff, I beg to inform you that when the particulars of the hatchway coamings and the supports and covers were forwarded to this Office by Mr. Stephenson, they were considered to be equivalent to the standard of the International Convention as applied to existing ships, and therefore it was not necessary for any instructions to be issued to him in respect of these coamings.

In reply to the enquiry contained in the third paragraph of your letter I may say that, according to the information in this Office, Mr. Stephenson's address is :-
