Mr. C. Stephenson, referred to in the attached letter from the Board of Trade, was a temporary Surveyor employed by this Society from April to September 1932.

It is submitted the Board of Trade be informed that when the particulars of the hatchways coamings and the supports and covers were forwarded, to this Office by Mr. Stephenson, they were considered to be equivalent to the standard of the International Convention as applied to existing ships, and therefore it was not necessary for any instructions to be issued to him in respect of these coamings.
