It will be necessary to call Mr. C. Stephenson, who surveyed the vessel for freeboard on the 19th May, 1932, and signed the report, the index number of which is 18679, to say whether the standard of strength in the coamings of this existing ship was such as to meet the general requirement that the strength was equivalent to that which would be required in a new ship.

If Mr. Stephenson had any doubt as to the strength of the coamings and referred the question to Headquarters, it may be necessary to call someone from Headquarters to deal with the instructions which were sent to Mr. Stephenson.

I shall be glad if you will let me know Mr. Stephenson's present address in order that I may have a Summons sent to him calling upon him to attend and give evidence.

It would be a help to me if you could obtain from Mr. Stephenson and let me have a statement showing precisely what he did, in order that this may be put before Counsel who is appearing at the Formal Investigation on behalf of the Board of Trade.

You will appreciate that the matter is urgent.
