S. With reference to the classification in the Society's Register Book of the steamer "FRATERNITY", I beg to acquaint you that I am in receipt of a letter from the Society's Surveyor at Montreal, from which it appears that the vessel has now become your property.

In this connexion I think it well to acquaint you that the Third Special Survey No.1 became due on this vessel in March, 1933 but has not yet been held, and the year of grace allowed for this Survey has consequently expired.

In addition a bower anchor and 130 fathoms of chain cable require to be supplied, and the Boiler Survey became due last May.

In the circumstances I shall be glad if you will kindly let me know what arrangements you propose to make for the above mentioned Surveys to be carried out.
