considerable financial troubles lately with the result that the
vessel has been seized for debt and is presently laid up in The
Engineering & Shipbuilding Co. yard in Quebec.

The vessel is to be sold at Public Auction tomorrow,
15th in Quebec and I will notify you the result of the
sale at the earliest.

I have already made a specification of the repairs
required to carry out the special survey and damage. In the
event of the vessel being again put into commission I hope to
recover my Fees from the new Owners'.


