In reply to your letter of the 5th June, 1934 with reference to the special survey No. 1 on the above mentioned vessel I regret to say that Captain Fournier has been having considerable financial troubles lately with the result that the vessel has been seized for debt and is presently laid up in The Engineering & Shipbuilding Co. yard in Quebec.

The vessel is to be sold at Public Auction tomorrow, 15th June, in Quebec and I will notify you the result of the sale at the earliest.

I have already made a specification of the repairs required to carry out the special survey and damage. In the event of the vessel being again put into commission I hope to recover my Fees from the new Owners'.

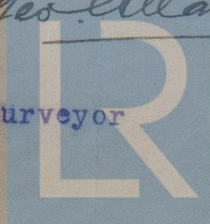
