the 3rd bow anchor to the Ss no 262,
building by them to class 100 A.1.

This anchor has apparently been used in
the Ss Indraghiri, owned by Messrs. Koyen & Co for whom
the vessel is being built, & having been
damaged has now been supplied with a new
"fluke" retested as regd by Table 22.

informed if this anchor can be accepted
for the vessel now building.
