**INDRASAMHA** (s).—Singapore, Jan. 10.—Indrasamha (here follows a mutilated code word which may possibly mean—put back with sundry losses and damages sustained in heavy weather); 24 feet of water in the forehold, 6 feet of water in the mainhold. Cargo being got out as rapidly as possible.

**INDRASAMHA** (s).—Singapore, Jan. 10, 10 50 a.m.—Indrasamha put back with sundry losses and damages sustained in heavy weather, 24 feet of water in the forehold, six feet of water in the mainhold. Cargo being got out as rapidly as possible.—[The above is corrected version of telegram published in issue of yesterday.]

**INDRASAMHA** (s).—Liverpool, Jan. 10, 3 12 p.m.—Telegram received by owners dated Singapore, Jan. 9, states:—Indrasamha put back leaky; she leaks dangerously; No. 1 compartment full; 6 feet water in main hold. She encountered high and dangerous cross seas. The extent of damage is not yet ascertained.

**INDRASAMHA** (s).—London, Jan. 11.—The Salvage Association have received the following telegram from Lloyd's Agent at Singapore, dated Jan. 11, re Indrasamha:—Indrasamha will certainly have to discharge forehold. Hope need not discharge others. Damage below water not yet ascertainable.
