The class is subject to the sole piece of the stern frame (E.W. 7,25 & 12,29) being specially examined at the next dry docking.

The 1st S.S.No.3, due 2,33, was partly held in dry dock in February 1933, see endorsement dated 19th ultimo.


The vessel has been laid up at Falmouth since April 1934 and the usual undertaking has been furnished.

The Owners now write stating that the vessel has been sold to Messrs. T.W.Ward Ltd., Sheffield, for breaking up, and was handed over to them on 27th ultimo.

According to Lloyd's Index the vessel left Falmouth on 31st ultimo in tow for Milford Haven.

It is submitted the vessel might be posted in the Register Book as "To be broken up".
