### H.M. TRAWLER OVERDUE AND CONSIDERED LOST

An Admiralty communique, issued on Friday, stated: "The Board of Admiralty regrets to announce that H.M. trawler Loch Inver (temporary skipper T. Harcastle, R.N.R.), is overdue and must be considered lost. The next of kin have been informed."  
The Loch Inver, 356 tons gross, was owned by the Caledonian Fishing Company, Ltd., of Aberdeen, and was built at Beverley in 1930.
