particulars of Casualty The Liverpool Surveyors examined this vessel afloat in October last for freeboard purposes and found considerable repairs were necessary for decks, framing, bulkheads, etc.

They stated that after discussion it was decided to scrap the vessel, and she has been sold to German purchasers for breaking up purposes, and they recommended that her class be dealt with.

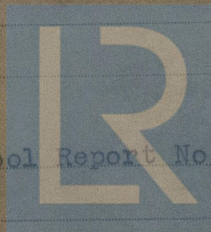
