A report has now come to hand from the Society's Surveyors at Glasgow stating that a complete survey of the hull & machinery of this vessel has been carried out for the 2nd Special Survey N°2 & recommendations have been made re repairs. In view however, of the extensive nature of these repairs, the Owners have sold the vessel to Mr. James Young, of Glasgow, for breaking up purposes.

In a letter, dated 13th June, received from the Glasgow office, it is stated that the work of demolition has now been commenced.
