
Dear Sirs,

H. With reference to the classification of the steamers "PORT VICTOR" and "PORT PIRIE" in this Society's Register Book I have to acquaint you I am in receipt of a letter from the Commonwealth and Dominion Line Ltd., of this City, intimating that these vessels have been sold to your goodselves.

In regard to the case of the steamer "PORT VICTOR" I have to acquaint you that the Boiler Survey became due at the end of May last and has been partly held and that to complete the same for the record BS H.35 the starboard forward and port and starboard after boilers require to be examined in their entirety and the safety valves of all boilers adjusted under steam. The Screwshaft Survey became due at the end of February last and the Committee agreed to this inspection being postponed until the vessel was recommissioned.

In the case of the "PORT PIRIE" I have to say that the Second Special Survey No. 3 became due at the end of February last and, in view of the fact that the vessel was laid up indefinitely, action has been deferred by the Committee.
