I shall be glad if you will kindly inform the Owners accordingly, and let me know immediately the work of demolition is commenced.

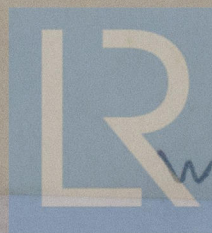
