has been sold for breaking up purposes, to Metal Industries Ltd., Rosyth.

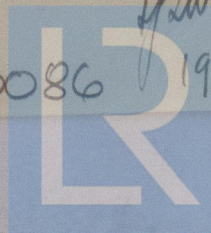
