
We beg to acknowledge the receipt of the
Certificate for the S. S. Austria with enclosed a letter
dated 27th instant and in regard thereto, we beg to inform
you that the Chains supplied on board of the above
mentioned Vessel have been made at the Chain Works
of Bruckl at which Works were made all the chains
supplied to other Vessels which were also been built
under Special Survey and Classed by this Society with
Record of F 100 A 1.

The Chain in question are always furnished with
the usual Testing Certificate issued by the Manufacturers
at which works they are tested and signed by the
Superintendent as also by the local municipal body
under which control the whole of the tests are made
which fully comply with Section 39. par. 5, Second part

The breaking test is given in the Certificate which
comply with table 22 -

We however propose to send to you the whole
of the Certificates in connection with the anchors and
Chains at the Vessel return to Trieste so that you can
ascertain yourself of the fact and give the Vessel her full
certificate and Class F 100 A 1, as to all other Vessels.
