Particulars of Casualty

This trawler ran ashore at Grindavik on the 10th April last.

Lloyd's Agent per Salvage Association stated that he found the vessel submerged partially broken & he considered salvage absolutely impossible.

A casualty notice was sent to the Owners on the 28th April, but sufficient time has not elapsed for a reply to be received.

The Reykjavik Surveyor, however, states in a communication dated 30th April that the vessel stranded on the south coast of Iceland on the 10th April & is totally lost.

SOURCE OF INFORMATION.

SKULI FOGETI.—Reykjavik, Apr. 10.—Steam trawler Skuli Fogeti ashore Grindavik and will probably be a total wreck.

SKULI FOGETI.—Reykjavik, Apr. 10.—Icelandic steam trawler Skuli Fogeti: Master and twelve members of the crew reported lost. (See issue of Apr. 11.)

SKULI FOGETI.—London, Apr. 13.—The following cable has been received from Samtrygging, Islenskra Botnvorpuaga, Reykjavik, dated Apr. 12:—Steam trawler Skuli Fogeti: Mate reports vessel about 60 fathoms from shore, ground very bad, fore-castle above water ebb tide. Thorsteinsson going stranding place next day, reporting position fully.

14/4

Reykjavik, Apr. 12.—Trawler Skuli Fogeti: Conferred with mate who considers vessel totally lost and salvage impossible. Going with Manager Samtrygging to stranding place for further inspection soonest possible. Shall wire after inspection.—Lloyd's Agent per Salvage Association.

SKULI FOGETI.—Reykjavik, Apr. 26.—Trawler Skuli Fogeti: Have been on spot. Vessel submerged and partially broken. Salvage considered absolutely impossible.—Lloyd's Agent per Salvage Association.
