The Rotterdam Surveyors report this vessel placed in dry dock, bottom coated and minor repairs effected.

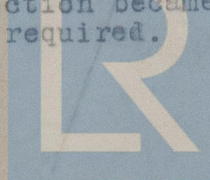
It is submitted the vessel appears worthy to remain as classed with record of survey 5.31.
