The 2nd S.S. No.2, due 4,31, has been partly held and to complete same double bottom tanks Nos. 2 & 6 require to be examined internally.

The vessel has been laid up and the Owners have furnished the usual undertaking.

In reply to enquiry, the Bremen Surveyors wrote on the 10th instant that the vessel is still laid up and it is intended to break her up in the course of this year.

In reply to further enquiry, the same Surveyors now write as follows:-

"-----I beg to inform you that this vessel has not been sold to Russia and that there have not been any negotiations for that purpose. I have been informed by the Hamburg Surveyors that it is stated by Messrs. Rederei-TreuhandGesellschaft, Hamburg, that this vessel is owned by them and that she will be broken up in the course of this year".

The year of grace expired 4,32.

It is submitted action be deferred.
