Dear Sirs,

With reference to the classification in the Society's Register Book of the steamer "GERMAR", I beg to inform you that to complete the Second Special Survey No.2 of this vessel, double bottom tanks Nos.2 & 6 require to be examined internally. As regards the survey of the machinery all the requirements of the Rules remain to be complied with, with the exception of the examination of the H.P. cylinder, pistons, H.P. and M.P. valves and sea connections.

The Committee have had this case under consideration to-day, and in view of the vessel being laid up and no arrangements having been made to complete the survey in question they will be agreeable to the vessel's class in the Register Book remaining undisturbed for the present, whilst she is laid up, subject to the conditions set forth on the enclosed form of undertaking, which I shall be glad if you will kindly sign and return to this Office.
