The 2nd S.S. No.2, due 4.31, has been partly held and to complete same double bottom tanks Nos. 2 and 6 require to be examined externally.

The case received consideration on the 31st May last when the decision was deferred and the Bremen Surveyors requested to inform the Owners that as the year of grace had expired definite arrangements must be made for the survey to be completed on the vessel's return to Bremen.

In reply to enquiry the Bremen Surveyors now write as follows:-

"This vessel is at present laid up at Bremerhaven. Regarding the completion of the Second Special Survey No.2 no definite statement could as yet be obtained from the Owners as they are considering the question whether she will at all be put into service again, or be broken up. If the vessel is put into commission again, everything is arranged to complete the s.s. No.2. As soon as I know what decision has been reached, I shall inform you of it."

The year of grace expired 4.32.

The case is submitted for the consideration of the Committee.
