The 2nd S.S. No.2, due 4.31, has been partly held and to complete same double bottom tanks Nos. 2 and 6 require to be examined internally.

The Bremen Surveyors on the 29th ultimo stated that the vessel was still laid up.

In reply to enquiry the same Surveyors now state the vessel was suddenly placed in commission again for a voyage to the Black Sea and there was no time to have the survey completed, and the Owners' Representative stated it will be carried out after the vessel's return in about three months.

The year of grace expired 4.32.
