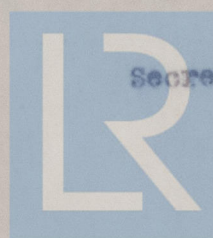
Before the Committee's approval can be given to the use of this cement, samples of the composition should be forwarded for their information shewing the thicknesses of the coating when finished.

It is also observed that the Builders have promised to obtain particulars of the material which will be forwarded in due course, when the matter will receive further consideration.
