In October last action in this case was deferred
 by the Committee as the vessel was laid up at Amsterdam and
 the then Owners furnished the usual undertaking.

A communication was received in November last
 from the Amsterdam Surveyors, from which it appeared that
 the vessel had been sold to be broken up, and in the
 circumstances the Committee deferred consideration of the
 case for a short time.

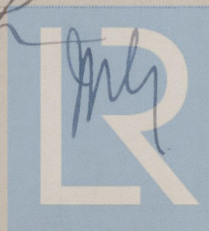
