Survey Due 2nd Special Survey No.3 due July, 1926 - Partly held. Boiler Survey due June, 1927 - Partly held. six months' limit on centre furnace of starboard boiler ( to renew ) expired October, 1927.

Action in this case has been deferred by the Committee as the vessel was laid up at Amsterdam and the Owners furnished the usual undertaking.

A communication has now come to hand from the Amsterdam Surveyors, from which it appears that the vessel has been sold to Messrs. The N.V. Handel Maatschappij v/h M. van Emden and will be broken up.

N.B. The Special Survey has been partly held on the machinery by the examination of the screwshaft, propeller, stern bush, sea connections and fastenings.
